## DAY 1

### MARSH CREEK STATE PARK

Spend the day at Marsh Creek State Park. Hike, bike, or horseback ride through miles of lush trails and paths. Cruise around the 535-acre lake by boat, paddle board or canoe. Break for a picnic at the park or enjoy lunch at delicious restaurants in nearby **Eagleview Town Center**.

### HOT AIR BALLOON RIDE

As the sun sets, there is no better adventure or view than from a hot air balloon ride. Brave a scenic float over the rolling countryside landscape.

### OUTDOOR DINING

This evening, dine outdoors on vibrant main streets throughout the countryside. West Chester, Phoenixville, Kennett Square and Ambler all offer vibrant outdoor dining settings with atmospheres as unique as their menus.

### DOWNTOWN KENNETT SQUARE

## DAY 2

### LONGWOOD GARDENS

Bask in botanical bliss at world-renowned Longwood Gardens. Situated on 1,077 acres, Longwood's 20 outdoor gardens and breathtaking indoor displays are designed to roam. The expansive 86-acre Meadow Garden features miles of walking and hiking trails filled with native plants and all the colors of nature. The open-air beer garden provides the perfect stop to refresh and relax.

### NORTHBROOK CANOE & DINE

The rambling Brandywine River winds throughout the picturesque Countryside. Visit Northbrook Canoe Company for a late afternoon Canoe & Dine adventure. The 2-hour canoe trip along the tree-tunneled Brandywine River ends at a charming campsite for a bonfire and picnic dinner.

## DAY 3

### VALLEY FORGE NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

Embark on a journey through history on a 10-mile driving loop throughout the 3,500 acres of Valley Forge National Historical Park. The drive includes major tour stops, and features some of the most scenic views of the park.

### KING OF PRUSSIA TOWN CENTER

Break for lunch at one of the many unique restaurants within the King of Prussia Town Center. Options include Davio's Northern Italian Steakhouse, Fogo de Chao, Founding Farmers, Mission BBQ and many more!

### GREEN LANE PARK

Green Lane Park offers a variety of year-round, outdoor activities and programs. Park visitors can enjoy fishing, boating (including boat rentals), family and group camping, picnicking, 25 miles of trails for horseback riding, mountain biking and hiking, as well as two children's playgrounds. Winter enthusiasts can cross-country ski, ice fish or go ice skating.

### RED BUFFALO RANCH

Enjoy a guided horseback trail ride! One hour or more through Evansburg State Park, and only 25 minutes away from Valley Forge National Historical Park.

### GOLF
