AMERICAN TREASURE TOUR

Take a guided tram tour through decades of American history. The American Treasure Tour is an expansive collection of American antiques and pop culture memorabilia, curated by an anonymous private collector. It features one of the largest displays of mechanical music in the country. Thousands of unique items are displayed over 100,000 square feet.

DAY 2

GLENCAIRN MUSEUM

Explore the Glencairn Museum, a castle-like mansion in Bryn Athyn Historic District. The history of world religion comes to life through an extensive collection of art and artifacts from a variety of different cultures and time periods. Take a guided stained-glass tour and experience live glass-blowing demonstrations incorporating medieval and European methods.

WHARTON ESHERICK MUSEUM

Take a guided tour of the Wharton Esherick Museum, the former hilltop home and studio of the Dean of American Craftsmen himself. Esherick was a sculptor who worked primarily in wood; his work is featured in the collections of The Philadelphia Museum of Art, The Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York, and many others. His whimsical Countryside homestead, featuring more than 200 of his works on display, is a National Historic Landmark for Architecture.

DAY 3

ANTIQUE ICE TOOL MUSEUM

Tour the Antique Ice Tool Museum to discover the forgotten history behind the natural ice trade. The museum is housed in a beautifully renovated 1834 stone bank barn, and home to the largest collection of antique ice tools and memorabilia in the United States. Step back in time and walk in the footsteps of the icemen, from the harvesting of ice to its delivery. Learn how this process profoundly impacted America's growth.

DOWNTOWN WEST CHESTER

Enjoy lunch and some main street shopping in historic downtown West Chester, one of the many vibrant towns throughout The Countryside of Philadelphia.

AMERICAN HELICOPTER MUSEUM

Discover the American Helicopter Museum, the nation's premier aviation museum dedicated to the incredible history of rotary flight. Learn about over 35 unique aircrafts on display, and for a special thrill, schedule a helicopter ride for a birds-eye view of the beautiful countryside.
